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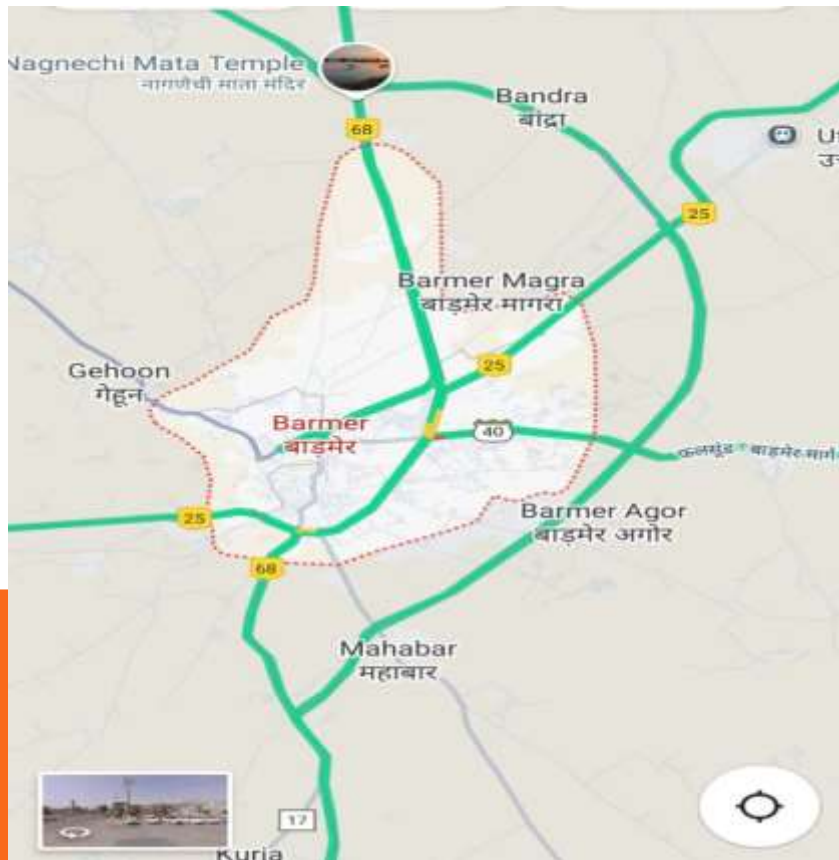

PROBLEM STATEMENT

MALNUTRITION AND VULNERABILITY AMONG SAHARIYA TRIBAL CHILDREN IN SHIVPURI

Sahariya tribal children in Shivpuri face high rates of malnutrition, especially Severe and Moderate Acute Malnutrition (SAM/MAM)

due to poverty, food insecurity, low awareness, and limited access to health and nutrition services.

Seasonal migration, poor maternal care, and weak government linkages further worsen their health outcomes.

Immediate, integrated action is essential to address these vulnerabilities and break the cycle of deprivation.

NUTRITION INTERVENTIONS

Goal: Tackle malnutrition among women & children

Key Actions:

- Treated 3,000 SAM/MAM children
- 5,000 Poshan Vatikas created
- 5,000 fruit & 3,000 moringa plants distributed
- Strengthened 295 Anganwadi/Nand Ghars

Impact:

- Reduced malnutrition rates
 - Awareness & garden ownership increased

HEALTH INTERVENTIONS

Screened: 3,800 pregnant women, 2,000 adolescents

Health Camps: 470

Trained: 570 frontline workers (ASHA, ANM, AWW)

Supplied: IFA tablets in 100 schools

Installed: 70 first-aid boxes

7 model toilets constructed, 1 renovated

3 vending machines & incinerators installed

1 RO in schools, 124 in communities

30 pad banks & 80 soap banks created
